Shiloh CDC strategically collaborates with employers, educational institutions, and other nonprofit organizations to develop a pathway for non-college graduates to obtain the industry certifications/skills, and experience needed to compete for jobs in the technology field.

Many of the people completing our eight-week web design and seven-week job readiness programs are changing careers, chronically unemployed, and/or retired. For many, our free web design class is their entry into the graphic design and HTML world.

Our students learn the techniques for developing a website, gain instructions on project management and time management, and more importantly, our students work on developing their first full website.
